The following services were rendered:

- In Medical Department, FIFTY EIGHT patients were checked.
- Surgical, Check up was seen in FORTY TWO patients and were advised accordingly.
- Gynaec Department, was run by eminent gynaecologist and TWENI EIGHT cases were examined.
- In Paediatric Department, THIRTY EIGHT children were checked to paediatrician.
- There were EIGHTEEN cases for E. N. T., who were properly check and advised.
- Dental Check up was done in TWELVE persons.
- Opthalmic, check up was done in SIXTEEN persons and we advised to wear spectacles.
- 8. E. C. G., was taken in TWENTY TWO cases.
- FOURTEEN cases were checked for Pathological problems include random Blood Sugar examinations.
- Screening was carried out in ONE HUNDRED & FIVE persons, out which FOURTEEN cases were positive.
- TWELVE persons took advantage of Orthopaedic Department.

Observation: TWO HUNDRED & FORTY FOUR persons took advantage of this camp activity. The crowd belonged to middle class, low incoming groups and hutment dwellers and were from the surrounding areas. Major of people were suffering from anaemia, chest diseases, skin problems, joi pains, chronic bronchites, peptic dyspepsias and chronic colitis.

Patients who are required surgical treatment were advised to go to the Government & Municipal Hospitals and reference notes were given to their

Thereafter, all dispersed with full job satisfaction at 2.30 p.m. and # organisers thanked all the doctors and staff members.
