Dr. S. S. Virdi, Dr. (Mrs.) Rekha Jajoo and Dr. T. M. Dhangre had examined chest diseases including tuberculosis and gave treatment to the chest patients and were advised to go to the nearby hospital for further treatment.

Dr. Pal had examined E.N.T. and Surgery cases totally FORTY EIGHT and gave them treatment and advise.

Dr. Nagraj Skin Specialist had examined FORTY EIGHT cases and of them TWO were declared to be having leprosy.

The dentist examined THIRTY FIVE cases and gave treatment to all.

Dr. (Mrs.) J. Gangar had examined ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY SEVEN cases and the deserving patients were given specs.

Dr. B. R. Kherdikar had examined HUNDRED cases including chest and Gynaec cases and deserving patients were given treatment.

**Observation :** The total number of cases attended the camp was HUNDRED TWENTY TWO.

TWO exhibitions of Leprosy and Family welfare were arranged at the premises of the camp and many people took advantage of the free treatment and advice from the camp.

It was appreciated by the people who had visited the exhibition, and the staff were fully satisfied with the job. The people request more such camps periodically held in their surroundings.

The camp activity went on till 4.30 p.m. Thereafter all the technicians and other staff dispersed with full job satisfaction.
