The Following activities were carried out :

1. Medical Check-up was done by Dr. B. R. Kherdikar, M.O., in TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY persons. The deserving persons were given proper advise & prescribed proper medicines.
2. Dr. S. S. Virdi, examined THIRTY TWO persons for chest diseases including Tuberculosis & those who were found in need to have further investigations were referred accordingly.
3. The E.C.G. check up were done at the spot, at the cost price of Rs. 10/- per E.C.G.
4. Dr. Rajpal examined TWENTY TWO persons for their E.N.T. problems

and gave proper advise and treatment.

5. TWO HUNDRED AND TWENTY TWO persons were checked for Ophthalmic problems and eye sight by Dr. (Mrs.) Gangar & Mr. Joshi and suitable spectacles with frames were provided at the spot on the cost price of Rs. 10/- only, remaining cost of Rs. 10/- was subsidised by the sponsors. Guidance & reference notes were given to patients whose ailments were in advanced stage and required surgery after further investigations.
6. Dr. Pawar examined & treated NINE dental cases.
7. Radiologist, Dr. Shantilal Shah and Dr. S. K. Parmani were also present at the site and gave proper advise and treatment to deserving persons.

Observations : FIVE HUNDRED AND FORTY ONE persons took advantage of this camp activity. Most of them belonged to middle and low income group. Some of them were suffering from heart diseases due to hypertension, diabetes, hyper - cholestrimia. Some of them took the prescriptions for getting the proper specialised medicines from outside.

The camp activity went on till 4.30 p.m. Thereafter all the doctors dispersed with full job satisfaction. The public showed their gratitude and expressed the desire that such camps may be held in future and all the staff will co-operate in the same way.
