The following camp activities was carried out :

1. Medical and Cardiac check up was done in ONE HUNDRED AND FIVE persons and deserving patients were given proper treatment and free medicine and advise. Dr. Pravin Mehta conducted the medical side while Dr. S. Vaishnav & Dr. H. Mehta and Dr. B. Sanchalia examined the children.
2. Surgical cases were checked up Dr. B. J. Jain and Dr. Chetan Shah. THIRTY FIVE persons were seen by them and deserving patients were given advise to continue their treatment from the mobile centre, Balwadi.
3. Gynaec cases were seen by Dr. (Mrs.) Cherry Shah and Dr. (Mrs.) Sharda Jaboria. HUNDRED AND TEN ladies were checked for their problems and were given advice treatment and also medicines from available stock accordingly.
4. E.C.G. was taken of TWENTY TWO referred persons through Rotary Club of Bombay free of charge, to solve their cardiac problems.
5. Screening was done by Mr. Waris free of cost in the Family Welfare clinic - cum - ambulance belonging to the ' The Family Planning and Medical Aid Trust '. SEVENTY TWO referred persons were screened for their chest problems out of which only two cases were found to be positive for T. B. The reports were given to the persons who were screened for their reference and record.
6. Blood Grouping and Rh was done free cost by Ms. Lissy and Ms. Archana in SIXTY TWO persons and they were given Blood Group cards in plastic covers for their reference and use in emergency.

**Observation :** The camp was held in Hiranandani complex School Building and therefore the rains could not affect the proceedings. FOUR HUNDRED AND TWENTY SIX persons took advantage of this camp. The arrangement for sitting for the patients was quiet satisfactory. Most of them belonged to low income group, casual labourers. They were mostly suffering from chest diseases, Gastric trouble, arthritis, anaemia, worm diseases and vitamin deficiency. They were advised to keep their surroundings clean and drink boiled water during rainy season and have a proper nourishing diet. The old people were advised to get their blood pressures checked regularly and have E.C.G. atleast once to rule out heart diseases.

The camp ended at 1.00 p.m. in a very pleasant atmosphere and all people dispersed for lunch which was well arranged by the sponsors.
