The following activities were carried out :

1. Medical and Cardiac Checkup was done in ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY persons, out of which THIRTY NINE persons were advised to take E. C. G. on nominal cost of Rs.10/- and the deserving patients were asked to take proper treatment from their near by hospitals.
2. Surgical and Orthopaedic patients were seen by Dr. S. P. Bopardikar patients requiring surgical treatment were advised to go to the near by hospitals and get operated. FORTY persons took advantage of this department, very rear cases of chronic cholecystitis, renal calculi were seen along with common problems of hernia, piles etc.

3. Gynaec patients were checked by Dr. Devyani Ghumre and Dr. Surekha Walke. FORTY TWO ladies and children were checked for their problems and were given treatment and medicine accordingly.
4. Ophthalmic check up was carried out in ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY persons and spectacles were given on nominal price of Rs.7.50. each. Deserving patients were given specs on nominal cost and rest were subsidised by the Lions Club. The cataract patients were advised to go to ophthalmic clinic for further treatment and operations.
5. Members of 'ALERT INDIA' took in charge of dermatology departments. SIXTY TWO persons took advantage of this department. People were advised not to be scared of leprosy as it is curable if proper treatment is given. No positive case of leprosy was detected.
6. Blood Grouping Rh & Diabetics checkup was done free of cost in ONE HUNDRED & TWENTY FIVE persons. They were given Blood Group cards in plastic covers for their reference & use in emergency.
7. Free Screening was carried out in our 'Family Welfare Clinic - Cum - Ambulance' belonging to 'The Family Planning & Medical Aid Trust'. EIGHTY ONE referred cases were screened for their chest problems, out of which only FOUR cases were found to be positive for T.B. Reports were given to the people who were screened for their reference & record.
8. Free Immunisation was given for Typhoid, Cholera, Triple vaccine, Tetanus toxide, polio and measles to THIRTY FOUR persons including children. They were given cards for their record mentioning all the relevant details.
9. Vitamin 'A' liquid was given to the children to prevent blindness. Iron & Multivitamin tablets were distributed free to anaemic ladies & patients, specially pregnant ladies.
10. Family Welfare Exhibition was set up Smt. Meena Kulkarni, coordinator and coloured posters were displayed at prominent places to create Health & Family Welfare awareness among the people & also to inform them about other infectious diseases.

Old people were advised to get their blood pressure checked regularly and have E.C.G. atleast once in a year to rule out heart diseases.

The camp ended at 1.30 p.m. in a very pleasing atmosphere and all the people dispersed for lunch which was well arranged by the sponsors.

Observations : SIX HUNDRED & SIXTY FOUR persons took advantage of this camp activity. Many of them were in contact of the Lion members from neighbouring colony. Most of them were from middle & low income group. Some of them were already being treated by other local doctors & in the municipal hospitals & had only come for the second opinion for treatment & advise. They were mostly suffering from chest diseases, gastric troubles, hypertension, Angina, arthritis, anaemia & vitamin deficiency. Worm infection was present in children. Patients for avitaminosis were given Vitamin A1 capsules.
