The following activities were carried out :

1. Medical check - up was carried out in TWO HUNDRED AND THIRTY FIVE mill workers. The patients were examined and accordingly sent for screening and laboratory investigations and E.C.G. & Ophthalmic check - up and were prescribed medicines and specs accordingly and those who could not afford it were given free of cost from our trust as

well as by the mill management.

2. Screening was carried out in our Family Welfare Clinic - cum - Ambulance free of cost in FOURTEEN workers, out of which two cases were found to be positive for Koch's and cardiac enlargement.
3. Pathological Investigation and 'Know your Blood Group' project was organised by our Trust. ONE HUNDRED & EIGHT persons go their Blood Grouping done. They were given their cards with their blood group and Rh factor in a plastic cover for their record.
4. Immunisation was carried out in SEVENTY THREE persons for tetanus toxide and T.B.
5. Ophthalmic check - up was carried out in FIFTY FOUR persons and deserving candidates were given specs at nominal cost of Rs. 10/- by Dr. Virdi's unit.
6. Our Co-ordinator Smt. Meena Kulkarni arranged the exhibition for Family Planning by hanging the posters and distributed condoms. Anaemic persons were given Iron, Folic Acid and Vitamin Tablets free of cost from the stock of the Trust.

**Observation :** The camp started exactly at 1.45 p.m. and went on till 5.30 p.m. Thereafter all our members were given snacks and tea and our staff members dispersed with full satisfaction and promised to come on the day for the camp for the next batch.
