The following investigations were carried out :

1. Dr. B. R. Kherdikar carried out Medical check - up in ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY persons & they were referred to different departments for further investigations and were accordingly prescribed medicines. Most of them were Rheumatic pains, arthritis, bronchitis, recurrent cold, loss of vision, insomnia & anoraxia.
2. E.C.G. was taken of TWENTY FIVE referred persons & Pulmonary & Cardiac patients were referred to K.E.M. Hospital for further investigations & treatment.
3. TWENTY SIX persons were checked for their eye problems & deserving persons were given specs at cost price of Rs. 20/-. Apart from refractory errors other eye diseases were diagnosed & prescription were given. Surgical cases were given notes to attend the ophthalmic department of K.E.M. hospital which is the nearest.
4. Screening was done in THIRTY FOUR referred persons. None was

5. positive for T.B., Cardiac features were also within normal limits. Dental Check-up was carried out by Dr. Rutha Waghmode & gave preliminary treatment & useful advise for Dental Hygiene. TWENTY FOUR persons were totally examined by her for their dental problems.
6. Blood Grouping was carried out in SEVENTY EIGHT persons, who were given their blood group cards in plastic cover alongwith their blood group and Rh factor for their reference. They were also explained the importance of Blood Donation. They were also informed about the blood bank, from where they can get a bottle of blood free whenever they need for their own self or for their relations, if they donate it.
7. Immunisation was carried out against, cholera, typhoid & tetanus toxide in FIFTY persons.
8. A group meeting of men was arranged by Smt. Meena Kulkarni among TWENTY FIVE persons. THREE packets of Oral Tablets and ONE HUNDRED pieces of condoms were distributed free of cost and all the advantages of spacing and sterilisation surgery was fully explained and their doubts were cleared.

Observations : The camp activity went on till 5.35 p.m. & thereafter all dispersed with complete job satisfaction. The authorities of the Mill as well as Volunteers & Workers were extremely co-operative, helpful, decent & well behaved, so much so that it was a great pleasure to render the services to them.
