The following activities were carried out:

 Group Meeting: A group meeting was taken among THIRTY FIVE persons. He advised them to keep their surroundings clean and not to allow stagnant water near about to prevent diseases like malaria, diarrhoea, typhoid, dysentry, gastroentritis, etc. He also advised them not to smoke and chew tobacco and pan & also not to drink alcohol, which may cause cirosis of liver.

Smt. Meena Kulkarni also took a small group meeting of about TWENTY TWO women. She explained them the importance of family planning and advised them to come to our centre at Colaba for free counselling of welfare problems.

Immunisation: Immunisation was carried out for typhoid, tetanus toxide, triple vaccine and polio in men and children. Only TWO children could be immunised

 Free Distribution of medicines: Pregnant and lactating women were given Iron, B-complex and Folic acid tablets and Vitamin A solution was given among children to avoid night blindness.

 TWO packets of condoms & TWO packets of Oral Pills were distributed & for further advise they were called to our centre at Colaba, on any working day between 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon.

Observation: This was second visit as such the members who had already taken advantage did not turn up again for the same purpose & the remaining people took full advantage of this second visit.

The situation of the zopadpatti had not changed & the nuisance was as it was, because of lack of education about sanitation.

The crowd responded very nicely & heard our talk patiently & also promised to come to our centre for further advise & help.
