The following investigations were carried out:

- Medical check up was carried out in ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY SEVEN persons, and were accordingly referred to different departments & prescribed & given medicines available with us & if not according to their ailments were requested to purchase from outside.
- E.C.G. was taken of referred patients, having cardio vascular complaints and hypertension.
- 3. ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY persons were given spectacles on nominal cost and those having eye trouble were prescribed medicines and eye drops accordingly and were given reference notes for further surgical treatment to K.E.M. hospital which is the nearest teaching municipal hospital.
- Screening was carried out in SIXTY THREE referred cases in our family welfare clinic - cum - ambulance and reports were given free of cost for their record. FIVE were abnormal.
- ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY persons took advantage of our 'Know Your Blood Group ' Project. They were given their Blood Group cards in Plastic covers free of cost for their use, either for Blood Donation or

Receiving Blood in emergency. TEN persons took advantage of Haemoglobin test.

- IMMUNISATION was carried out in FIFTY THREE persons, against Tetanus Toxide and T.A.B. vaccine.
- Family Welfare Exhibition was arranged by Smt. Meena Kulkarni who explained the workers the importance of small family and distributed condoms among males and oral tablets for their females for spacing the children in their families.

Observations: About FIVE HUNDRED AND TWENTY persons took advantage of this camp. The crowd was belonging to the Muslim Community and were from middle income group. The common disorders found among them were spondylitis, diarrhoea, dysentry, worm infection, anaemia, chest diseases like bronchitis, tuberculosis, etc. The ladies and children were found to be anaemic and mal nutrition. They were advised to take nourishing diet like leafy vegetables, milk, fruits, soyabean, etc. They were explained to keep their surroundings clean the importance of health and to keep their surroundings clean,

All the staff members camp back in 'Family Welfare Clinic-cum-Ambuafter the camp activities were over at 3.30 p.m. The camp activity was successful & then was air of satisfaction on the faces of patients and Doo - cum - staff. The sponsorers arranged nice lunch, photos & video show of the whole camp & bid send off to all. This is for information & record
