After the first camp we took another camp at Jacob Circle in the premises of Fevicol Factory, in the same order which was sponsored by Jeevan Prakash Nursing Home, Andheri, Marol, Bombay - 59. About THREE HUNDRED AND FIFTY took advantage of this camp.

Most of them were factory workers. Some of them were treated by Dr. Vibha Agarwal, Dr. Mukesh Agarwal and Dr. Ramesh Dargad.

They were mostly suffering from chest diseases, gastric troubles, hypertension, angina, arthritis, anaemia and vitamin deficiencies. Worm infection was present in children. Patients for A - Vitaminosis were given Vitam A syrup.

Dr. (Mrs.) Gangar took in charge of Ophthalmic department and spectacles were distributed to the needy persons on cost price of Rs. 20/- each. E.C.G. of deserving patients was also taken on cost price of Rs. 10/- each. About THREE HUNDRED AND FIFTY persons took advantage of this camp.

The camp ended at 5.35 p.m. in a pleasing atmosphere and all the people dispersed after lunch which was very well arranged by the sponsors. Arrangement for tea and snack was made by the organisers.
