Following activities were carried out :

1. The Medical Department including Cardiological Department was seen by Dr. H. V. Pophale and gave proper medicine and advise to the deserving patients. About ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY patients attended the O.P.D. Three cases of Leprosy diagnosed, months treatment given and reference was given to PHC for follow up ;
2. E.C.G. was taken in ONE HUNDRED AND FIVE cases on nominal cost price of Rs. 10 per case by the team of Dr. S. S. Virdi ;
3. The Surgical Department was run by Dr. S. P. Bopardikar and NINETY SIX patients were given treatment, surgical advise and references. Most interesting cases such as Parotid Tumor in infant of NINE months, Mammary Tumour in a woman, Congenital Hernia in a child and Hydrocele of cord ;
4. General Medical Examination & Family Planning and advise was given by Dr. B. R. Kherdikar to EIGHTY SIX patients. Patients were largely Peptic Dyspepsias, Arthritis, Bronchitis, Asthma, Anemia and Avitaminosis ;
5. Dr. Devyani was in charge of Gynaec Department. SIXTY EIGHT ladies took advantage of this department & got their problems treated;

6. Dr. Zarina Altabi took in charge of Paediatric Department and checked FIFTY EIGHT patients and gave proper treatment, advise to the deserving patients. Vitamin 'A' to the children was given by mouth to prevent blindness, vitamins, iron and antibiotics were given for controlling diseases ;
7. Immunisation was done for cholera, typhoid, polio, tetanus and triple vaccine in SIXTY persons including children referred by Ms. Zarina Altabi ;
8. Ophthalmic Department was run by Dr. Jayavani Gangar and the deserving candidates were given specs on nominal cost price. About TWO HUNDRED persons took advantage of this department ;
9. Blood Grouping was done in ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY SIX persons and the cards in plastic covers were issued ;
10. Screening was done in FIFTY FOUR persons, out of which TWELVE cases were found to be positive for Tuberculosis. They were given ten days treatment and referred to Primary Health Centre at Koproli.

ONE THOUSAND AND THREE persons took advantage of this Camp activity. They mostly belonged to lower middle class, lower income group and adivasis. Many of them were suffering from skin infections due to scabies and ringworm. Persons requiring further treatment were advised to continue the treatment from Primary Health Centre at Koproli. Breakfast and Lunch was arranged by members of Lions Club of Chembur.

Thereafter, all dispersed with full job satisfaction at 3.00 p.m. with complete satisfaction and reached the centre at 5.20 p.m.




