The team of 'The Family Planning & Medical Aid Trust', started from the Centre at 8.00 a.m. and reached the site at 9.00 a.m. The following staff members took part in the camp activities :

Following activities were carried out :

1. MEDICAL DEPARTMENT was conducted by Dr. B. R. KHERDIKAR, who examined ONE HUNDRED & EIGHTY persons. And the deserving patients were given proper treatment and also advise for investigations. Some were referred to other specialities, Immunisation and Blood Grouping.
2. OPHTHALMIC check - up was done by DR. M. D. DESHMUKH, DR. S. S. VIRDI, DR. KASHYAP & DR. (Mrs.) GANGAR. They examined SIXTY FOUR persons and the deserving patients were given spectacles on nominal cost price of Rs. 10/- only. Probably the remaining Rs. 10/- might have been subsidised by the sponsorers.
3. SKIN DISORDERS ALONGWITH LEPROSY DETECTION : An exhibition was attended by Dr. G. S. MANE, MR. BHAI DHABHOLKAR, MR. ABA, MR. DILIP, Ms. CLERA. They examined THIRTY EIGHT persons, few suspected cases of leprosy were referred for investigations in order to confirm the diagnosis. The patients and public appreciated the exhibition which was done there for the first time.
4. DENTAL unit consisted of DR. SHARAD KARLE, DR. HITTA SONAWANE, DR. VEERENDRA ZAVERI, DR. SUNITA SHARMA, DR. DIWAKAR D. DHARGALKAR, DR. ASHOK JAIN, DR. PARUL MEHTA, who checked dental cases and prescribed the necessary treatment and investigations in THIRTY TWO persons.
5. BLOOD GROUPING was done by Ms. LISSY in ONE HUNDRED & FOUR persons who were given Blood Group cards in plastic covers

which the persons were very happy to receive. They were advised to carefully preserve so that they can donate or receive help in emergency.

6. IMMUNISATION was done by Ms. ANITA in TWENTY EIGHT cases for T.A.B., Triple, Polio, Cholera and Tetanus. Cards of inoculations were issued to everyone. Majority received T.A.B. vaccine only.
7. EIGHTY TWO patients were examined in the Gynaec Department by the Doctors of the Lions Club of Bandra.

Observations : It was surprising that even in the rains the attendance of FIVE HUNDRED & EIGHT persons was there, who took advantage of this camp activity. Most of them belonged to Muslim community and were suffering from Bronchitis Asthama, anaemia and skin diseases like scabies, ringworm, exzema, dermatites. Men, women & children were examined and treated. Children were sufferin from malnutrition and worm diseases and diarrhoea. Many of the adults were addicted to tobacco chewing, tobacco tooth powder and tobacco smoking. They were explained the ill effects of tobacco.

Thereafter, all dispersed with full job satisfaction at 3.30 p.m. The organisers arranged a good lunch thanked all the Doctors and other staff members for their voluntary services even on rainy day.
