Our team of ' The family Planning and Medical Aid Trust ' started from the centre at 9.00 a.m. and reached the site at 9.30 a.m. and started the camp activities. The following staff members took place in the camp activities :

The following activities were carried out at the camp site :

1. Medical check - up was done in ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY FIVE persons and those who were found necessary to have a further E.C.G. check - up were advised to do on the spot.
2. Surgical check - up was done in SEVENTY FOUR cases and the deserving patients were given treatment and surgical advise and reference notes.
3. FIFTY FOUR persons were seen for their E.N.T. problems and were given proper advise and treatment.
4. Leprosy eradication committee took in charge of the Dermatology Department and checked THIRTY FOUR persons for their skin problems while some cases were referred Lion Tarachand Bapa Hospital for further investigations and Ear Clip Test.
5. ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY THREE persons were checked for Ophthalmic problems by expert doctors and suitable spectacles with frames were provided on the spot, free of cost while the cost price was subsidised by the sponsorers. Guidance was given for patients whose ailments were in advanced stage and required surgery in the hospitals.
6. Gynaec & Paediatric Department was done by Dr. B. R. Kherdikar and TWENTY SIX persons were checked and advised medicines accordingly.
7. Blood Grouping was done in ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHT cases by Ms. Usha and Ms. Archana. People were given their respective blood

- group cards.
8. Immunisation was done for Typhoid, Cholera, Triple Tetanus Toxide and Polio in ONE HUNDRED AND FOURTEEN persons by Ms. Anita and immunisation cards were issued.

Observation : SEVEN HUNDRED AND TWENTY EIGHT persons took advantage of this camp activity. Most of them belonged to the middle income group and mostly were employees, businessmen and factory labour. People were advised to take medicines prescribed and which were not available from the nearby medical stores were subsidised by their employers.

Some of them were suffering from Diabetes, Obesity and cardiac and kidney problems. Diabetes patients were advised to keep control on their diet and stick to their diabetic regime.

Women and children were found to be anaemic and were suffering from chest problems like bronchitis, sinusitis and influenza. Many children were suffering from malnutrition and chronic respiratory infections. The camp activity was carried out till 4.00 p.m. All the doctors and their

technicians and assistants were given small gifts by their sponsors and thereafter all dispersed with full job satisfaction.

The public showed their desire that such camps may be repeated in future and all the staff to help in the same way.

Dr. Kenkre, M. D. had decided to give such camp at Sion and requested others to co-operate.
