The Following activities were carried out in the camp:

Surgeon, Dr. Vijay Deshmukh examined arround Ninety Five patients. Most of his patients complained about Indigestion, Mucus in Stool, Hyperacidity. His opinion regarding the common diseases in Traffic Police was due to irregularity in food, more spicy food, standing in the same position for a longer period. 10% of the patients suffered because of Alcohol and Tobacco chewing. All the patients were given free advice and prescription.

The Opthalmic Department was well managed by Dr. Ajit Hajari from K.E.M. Hospital. He examined arround Thirty patients whoose common complaint was reddness in eyes, watering of eyes, short & long sightedness. He said the reason could be that they are exposed to more dust particles pollution etc. some of the patients had retina problem due to High Blood Pressure and diabetic. These persons were advised to get their eye checked every year.

The Orthopeadic Department was looked by Orthopeadic Surgeon Dr. Sharad Bhure. He examined around Ten to Fifteen patients. Mainly complaining of knee joint pain and swelling over legs which could be to his opinion because of standing in the same position for longer period.

A Panel of Skin Specialist were present viz. Dr. Shailendra, Dr. Deepak Ringanekar, Dr. Santosh Zuzer, Dr. D.G. Sapale, Dr. Satish Wadhwa all from G.T. Hospital examined arround THIRTY FIVE TO FOURTY patients C/o Haemotoma, Eszema, Skin infection, swelling of veins and so on. He says that this could be because of various reasons like standing in one position, quality of clothes used by them is not good, the belt which they tie on the vest are too tight which hinders the blood circulation and so on. Every body were given free advise.

DR. V. H. Salaskar, Dr. Nilang Shah did the General checkup of around FIFTY TO FIFTY FIVE patients. Some of them had blood pressure, diabetic problems. Proper advvise and line of treatment were given to the needed persons.

Laboratory Investigations mainly blood grouping and blood sugar estimation was done by our staff members Mrs. Shehnaz Presswala and Mrs. Swati Kadam. They did NINETY FIVE blood groups among which FOUR had Rh-factor negative. Around Twelve blood sugar was estimated and Two to Three were found to be diabetic.

Around SIXTEEN pockets of contraceptive were freely distributed by Mr. D.P. Gawai, Public Relation Officer The Family Planning & Medical Aid Trust, Mumbai.

OBSERVATION: The camp was organised under the supervision of Mr. D.P. Gawai Public Relation Office "The Family Planning & Medical Aid Trust", Dr. Jayshree Zaveri President, College of Physician & Surgeon, Parel, Mumbai and Ex. P.M. and wellknon personality Dr. V. H. Khuntal helped in managing the camp.

The camp ended with the introduction of all the Doctors , with each other and a breakfast.
