The patients deserving necessary investigations i.e. E.C.G. & Screening of the Chest for final diagnosis and further appropriate treatment. The surgical patients were asked to take the operative treatment from the nearby Hospital. The cardiological problems were diagnosised by E.C.G. and given the treatment which is necessary for them.

#### **IMMUNISATION:**

Immunisation counter was managed by our staff nurse Mrs. Susamma Thomas and Ms. Vandana Shinde. They managed to take Thirty One persons for knowing their Blood Group which is very essential for any emergency arising during accidents.

### **FAMILY WELFARE COUNSELLING:**

This counter was made separate for exclusive for males about NINETY pieces of Condom were distributed among men. This counter was well decorated with exhibits and posters in order to draw the attention of all the eligible couples.

### **OBSERVATION:**

About NINETY EIGHT Traffic Police took advantage of this big camp, organised by us at "Traffic Police Head Quarters", 3rd Floor, Worli, Mumbai - 400 001. Dr. Suhas Pophale Physician Surgeon and Mr. D.P.
