GROUP MEETING:

A group meeting was arranged by our Medical Officer **Dr. B.R. Kherdikar.** TWENTY NINE persons including Men, Women & Childrens were present at the camp site. **Dr. B.R. Kherdikar** told them to keep their surrounding clean with the help of local leaders. They were further adviced to have the Immunisation done of their childrens as well as adults. he then explained the importance of Family Planning by using various methods available and a special care to be taken during ante-natal and post-natal care.

IMMUNISATION:

This counter was well managed by our senior staff nurse Mrs. Susamma Thomas. She immunised **FOURTEEN** persons for Typhoid, Tetanus Toxide, Polio and Measles. All the persons who took the vaccination were given Immunisation cards for their information and record.

FAMILY WELFARE COUNSELLING:

This counter was well arranged by Mrs. Archana Tawade. She arranged Family Planning Exhibition and free distribution of Condoms and Oral Tablets. About SIXTY pieces of Condoms were distributed among men and SEVEN pockets of Oral tablets were distributed among women for help in spacing the children in their family.

OBSERVATION:

About TWENTY NINE persons took advantage of this camp activities. They were explained the importance of Health by taking nourishing diet. All the persons were given anti-anaemic drugs like Iron and Folic Acid tablets, the ohter persons were given prescription. Many childrens were found to be suffering for worm infection, skin diseases (scabies) Malnutrition Diarrhoea and Respiratory infection. All the persons who took the advantage of this camp were very happy to receive the treatment given to them after careful examination.

The registration fee Rs. One from each patient was collected as usual and total amont Rs. 29/- (Rupees Twenty Nine only) are credited in the Trust account as participants contribution.
