INTRODUCTION

The camp was inaugurated by Hon'bnle Guest Dr. H.V. Pophale Chairman The Family Planning & Medical Aid Trust", Mumbai - 400 039. Mr. Sudhir Kamble President "Jai Maharashtra Mandal", Mrs. Medha Todankar Chief Shivsena Mahila Aghadi, Mira Road and Mrs. Bina Sharma Shakha Pramukh, Mira Road was also present on the occasion. Mr. Sudhir Kamble and Medha Todankar gave information about various social activities of "Jai Maharashtra Mandal" for the last few years.

MEDICAL CHECK-UP:

This department was conducted by the renound Doctors of Mumbai, Dr. H.V. Pophale Cardiologist, Dr. Bhopardikar General Surgeon, Dr. Suhas Pophale Physician Surgeon and Dr. B.R. Kherdikar Medical Officer. About TWO HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE persons took advantages of this departments. The persons who approached with Chest disorders were very well taken care by Dr. H.V. Pophale and accordingly they were directed to the respective counters. The Surgical cases were well handled by Dr. Bhopardikar. All of them were very much satisfied by the type of services, advices and line of treatment given to them. The deserving patients were advice to take E.C.G. and Screening of the Chest to co-relate, the clinical diagnosis and were given the desired treatment.

IMMUNISATION:

Immunisation counter was managed by our staff Nurses Mrs. Alka Sawant and Mrs. Sharda Parab. They Immunised about Fifty Four persons for Tetanus and Typhoid. They all were issued Immunisation Cards in plastic covers mentioned with date and name of the Vaccine and the next due date to be followed.

LABORATORY INVESTIGATIONS:

This Counter was very well managed by our experienced Lab. Staff viz. Miss Lissy George, Mrs. Swati Kadam and Mrs. Babita Bharadwaj. Around one Hundred Twenty Five persons gave their Blood out of which Four were found to be with RH Negative Factor. They were also issued Blood

Group Identity Cards endorsed with necessary details for their reference while donating or receiving the Blood in Emergency.

SCREENING OF THE CHEST AND E.C.G.:

Screening of the Chest and E.C.G. Counter was managed single handed by Mr. Babu M.S. our X-Ray Technician. He screened about Ninty cases in our Family Welfare Clinic-cum-Ambulance, out of which Two cases were of Heart enlargement, Three persons were of Koch's, Two persons were of Pneumonitis and other Nine cases were found of B.V.M. increased.

E.C.G. DEPARTMENT:

This department was also conducted by Mr. Babu M.S. singole handedly. Thirty Five persons were suffering from Cardiac problems out of which Twenty Two persons were found to be abnormal and they were referred to Cardiological Department for final opinion, advise and further treatment.

DENTAL CHECK-UP:

Dr. Rajesh Gaikwad and Dr. Pravin Gaikwad treated Eighteen cases with Dental problems. They extracted loose teeth and others were treated medically. This Dental Department was very effective and helpful to the patients with chronic toothache and hanging lose teeth. Both Doctors did a wonderful job satisfying the persons in the best possible way.

E.N.T. COUNTER:

This E.N.T. counter was conducted by **Dr. B.R. Kherdikar.** He did his best to dispose of their duties on this E.N.T. counter to the utmost satisfaction of the attending patients. The various problems pertaining to ears were solved giving them the desired prescription, treatment and advise. **Thirty Two**

persons took advantage of this Counter.

OPHTHALMIC COUNTER:

Ophthalmic Counter was conducted by Mr. Kasim Hussain Khan. One Hundred Eighteen persons were examined by him for various eye disorders.

FAMILY WELFARE EXHIBITION-CUM-COUNSELLING COUNTER:

This counter of Family Planning was well decorated with Exhibits and Posters of Family Welfare in order to draw the attention of all the eligible couples. **Mrs. Archana Tawade** adviced to all the attending couples to space the children after one child by using various methods of Family Planning. She distributed **Sixty** pieces of Condoms and **Six** pockets of Oral tablets to regular users.

OBSERVATION:

About Two Hundred Twenty Five persons took advantage of this camp activity. The organisers of "Jai Maharashtra Mandal", Shantinagar, Mira Road, Dist. Thane - 401 107 were extremly helpful, Co-operative and Courteous they were received our medical services in a very orderly manner and appreciated the type of service render to them. The sponserers also served Tea Snacks and Lunch to the Staff and Doctors. The camp activities ended with great appreciation on behalf of Patients, Organisers and Management.
