IMMUNISATION:

Immunisation counter was well managed by Mrs. Susamma Thomas Senior Staff Nurse. She Immunised FIFTY FIVE persons for T.T., Typhoid and Oral Polio vaccine.

FREE DISTRIBUTION OF MEDICINES:

All the medicines were purchase through the authorities of 'Samata Parishad Mumbai' and dispensed by The Family Planning & Medical Aid Trust' to deserving patients free of cost. The anemic patients were given Iron and Folic Acid tablets for the period of one month. They were also given multi-vitamin and B-Complex tablets for better health.

OBSERVATION:

About FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY FOUR patients took advantage of this camp activity. All the patients were very poor and therefore the special attention was given to every patients as to how and when the dose to be taken. They were explain the use of nurising diet in their daily diet. They were also told about the fresh and bacteria free water for drinking purposes in order to avoided the water born diseases like Typhoid, Cholera, Gastroentertis, Dysentery and worm infection. On the whole the camp was quite successful and all the staff returned back at about 4.00 p.m. with job satisfaction.
