FAMILY WELFARE EXHIBITION-CUM-COUNSELLING

This counter was well managed by **Ms. Anjali Rane** Asstt. Co-ordinator **Mrs. Archana Tawade** F.W. Ahya. This counter was decorated with Banners and Posters of Family Welfare in order to draw the attention of all the eligible couples. **FIVE** pockets of Condoms and **THIRTY TWO** pockets. of Oral pills were given to the eligible couples.

FREE DISTRIBUTION OF MEDICINES :

Drugs purchased by the Trust for this project were freely given to the needy people. Medicines for minor and common ailments were also dispensed. Iron and Folic Acid Tablets, Calcium, Multi-Vitamin, Anti-pyretic and other Anti-biotic tablets were given free of cost.

OBSERVATION :

The site was chosen for benefit of Remote Rural and Adivasi people in the areas and the exhibits of Agricultural Dept., Haffkine Institute., Forest Dept., Food and Nutrition Unit and Public Health Centre (P.H.C.) were informative and taught the people how to cope and active and get better results within the means locally available.

Every Government Officer including the local Tahasildar were astounded by the large turnout for the camp and it was repeatedly expressed by many of them.

About ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY FIVE persons took advantage of this Free Health Camp activity. This Health Camp was extremely successful, it was carried out in a very disciplined and systematic way with the help of local leaders, officers and dignitaries. Plastic carry bags were given to every patients for carrying the medicines.
