INTRODUCTION:

The joint efforts of B.M.C. "A" Ward staff and "The Family Planning & Medical Aid Trust Staff were organised with the help in C. Govt. eradication on programme of the disease of Poliomylitis from India by giving Polio Oral Immunisation to every child below 5 years of age. The Project activity started in early morning at 7.45 a.m. because of the Propaganda already made, the response was tremendous. About Seven Hundred Ninety Seven' children were Immunised under Pulse Polio Immunisation programme at the above Three Centres. The whole team was divided into Three Divisions and the staff was distributed with polio

vaccine in well protected Ice-Jars supplied by the **B.M.C. & Trust Depts.** to keep the Polio vaccine at required temperature.

The first Pulse Polio eradication programme was started on 9th December, 1995 and 20th January, 1996, it was for only children below 3 years of age. The second Pulse Polio programme was fixed on 7th December, 96 and 18th January, 97 but this time the children were taken up below 5 years. They were told that the extra dose to be given to every child inspite of their regular dose.

OBSERVATION:

The previous night the Pulse Polio cassets were shown on Video Screen at 'Geeta Nagar'. The sites for Centres for Pulse Polio Programme were provided by 'Workers of Rotary Club', Dr. Arun Ghate Medical and Health Officer 'A' Ward, 'Shivsena Workers' and Fourth Centre was well conducted

by The Chairman, The Family Planning & Medical Aid Trust' Dr. H.V. Pophale and also B.M.C. Staff. The local social workers were very helpful to us by bringing the children in large number to our Centre. Dr. H.V. Pophale Chairman The Family Planning & Medical Aid Trust' visited all the Centres and after supervision gave the detailed information and knowledge about Pulse Polio Immunisation under extended programme and its importance.
