## CARDIALOGICAL EXAMINATION:

This department was conducted by **Dr. H.V. Pophale.** About ONE HUNDRED SIXTY SIX patients were examined by him. The deserving patients were adviced for E.C.G. or Screening of the Chest to corelate the dinical diagnosis. The prescription was also given to them after full investigation.

#### GYNAECOLOGY COUNTER:

This counter was taken care by **Dr. Jayshree Zaveri and Dr. Jyoti Taskar.** They examined **EIGHTY NINE** ladies attending this counter and they were given further opinion and advice.

#### PAEDIATRIC DEPARTMENT:

This department was well managed by **Dr. Jayshree Zaveri Gynaec and General Physician** about ONE HUNDRED TEN children were examined by them and advice to Immunised their children periodically to protect them from various diseases.

### E.N.T. CHECK-UP:

This department was managed by **Dr. Kuldeep Singh.** He examined about ONE HUNDRED TWENTY SEVEN patients pertaining to ear were attended and giving them appropriate prescription, treatment and advices.

#### **GENERAL CHECK-UP:**

This department was very well managed by **Dr. B.R. Kherdikar and Dr. Archana Mule.** About ONE HUNDRED FIFTY FIVE patients were examined by them.

## LABORATORY INVESTIGATION:

This counter was well managed by our experienced Lab. staff Mrs. Swati Kadam, Miss. Manisha Shinde and Miss

**Seema Thube.** They examined **ONE HUNDRED** persons for Blood Group, **SEVENTY TWO** persons for Blood Sugar and FORTY persons for heamoglobin. They were issued respective blood group cards in plastic covers for their emergencies and record.

#### E.C.G. COUNTER:

This counter was conducted by **Mr. Babu M.S.** About SIXTY EIGHT patients were referred by him. Most of the patients were found suffering from I.H.D. and other heart problems. They were further advice from **Dr. H.V. Pophale** to give his opinion and treatment.

## X-RAY, SCREENING OF THE CHEST:

This counter was also managed by our X-Ray Technician Mr. Babu M.S. our X-Ray Technician. About FIFTY FIVE persons were referred in our Family Welfare Clinic-cum-Ambulance for the various Chest & Heart problems. Many of them were found for Broncho Vascular Markings.

#### **OBSERVATION:**

THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY NINE persons took advantage of this camp activity. The camp was arranged in such a way that all who attended the camp was given the entire facilities in a large hall where all the specialist Doctors were available with their equipments.

The attending patients were happy to receive the way of treatment and services given to them in a systematic manner.

All the staff left the site at about 3.30 p.m. with full job satisfaction.
