#### **GROUP MEETING:**

This group meeting was addressed by **Dr. B.R. Kherdikar** Medical Officer and **Mr. D.P. Gawai P.R.O.** Dr. B.R. Kherdikar delivered a speech about how to keep their surrounding area clean as far as possible to protect themselves from various water born diseases like Cholera, Gastroentertists, Typhoid etc. The incidence of Malaria cases can be control if there is no stragnent water near the hutments. **Dr. B.R. Kherdikar** adviced the importance of keeping good health, if paid little attention towards regular exercise, nourishing diet, avoid drinking, smoking and chewing tobacco etc. The pregnent women were adviced to take proper care by consumption of green vvegetables, fruits and milk and to get themselves imminised by taking Tetanus Toxide.

#### **IMMUNISATION:**

Immunisation was carried out by our Staff Nurse Mrs. Alka Sawant in Forty Seven persons including men, women and children against Cholera, Typhoid and Measels. All of them were issued cards mentioning the date, name of the vaccine and next due date to be followed.

#### FREE DISTRIBUTION OF MEDICINES:

Medicines like Iron and Folic acid tablets were distributed freely among the anaemic people. The other persons were given the prescription according to their complaints put forward during medical cheked up on the spot.

## FAMILY WELFARE COUNSELLING & EXHIBITION:

This counter was arranged by Mrs. Vidhya Gaikwad, Sixty pieces of Condoms were distributed among men and Six Pockets of Oral tablets were distributed among women for spacing the children in their family.

#### **OBSERVATION:**

About **Eighty Four** persons took advantages of this camp activity. **Mr. D.P. Gawai** contacted the local leaders of the locality and get their active coordination during the camp. The enthusiasm among the candidates was really praise worthy. All the staff were return with job satisfaction at 4.00 p.m.
